Trail/Road Ride



On Saturday, **May 24, 2014** (rain date: 5/25) a combination trail/road ride is planned. The Columbia Trail ride, up in the northern end of the county, is a 22 mile loop (roundtrip) beginning in High Bridge. Highlights will include Union Forge, Ken Lockwood Gorge and the Gorge Bridge Train Wreck. Riders can buy lunch at historic Long Valley Pub & Brewery before returning to ride start. The trail is packed gravel, road is paved. Mountain or Hybrid bikes are appropriate for this ride, but road bikes should also be fine.
