Don't wait, because tickets are going fast for the East Amwell Historical Society Annual Holiday House Tour! This year we have four great houses, each unique and interesting.

- We will visit a newly renovated 1749 farm house that mixes old timber frame construction with contemporary openness. The architect owners have added a spacious family kitchen with cathedral ceiling overlooking the Back Brook and a gallery link to the studio/garage, encompassing a private deck.
- Next will be one of the earliest houses in the township with a 15' cut stone, walk-in fireplace, winding staircase to a loft above, and a new country kitchen. Behind this home, a post and beam barn -- moved from Linvale -- has been re-erected by the New Jersey Barn Company.
- Then, we move on to an incredible house filled with antiques that was built in 1912 on a foundation from an earlier house which was destroyed in a fire. Recent built-ins, moldings and a wonderful airy look and feel make this house special. Please don't let their white cat Skeezics out!
- Finally we will finish the tour at a three-story stone barn/house which has recently undergone a total renovation. While waiting to enter, you'll see the homeowner's craft shed and go into an adjoining barn that may have the largest beams in the township.
