ACTIVITY 1: FIND AND SEEK STICKERS

Biographies of the departed and activity sheet stickers can be found at the <u>name underlined</u> grave. Read also about and look for the graves of the <u>name bolded</u> individuals buried nearby in the same cemetery (cemetery locations are on the following page). See if you can find historian Theodore Bellis' name (other than at Prospect Hill).

- 5. Cemetery at Clover Hill Park- Waldron Family
- 6. Francis Geary's Grave- off Rt 31, Cornet Way exit (lecture scheduled Nov 15th)
- 7. Pleasant Ridge Cemetery- Captain John Schenck
- 8. Amwell Ridge Cemetery (Larison Corner Cemetery AKA Amwell United First Presbyterian Cemetery)-Johann Peter Rockefeller and Reverend Jacob Kirkpatrick For 6, 7 and 8, Check out Youtube: Hidden History America, David Deutsch
- **9.** Mount Airy Cemetery (Second English Presbyterian Church Cemetery)- <u>David and Deborah Johnes and children</u> and Mount Airy Cemetery Annex- <u>Prime Moore</u>

- 11. Rosemont Cemetery- Mary and Daniel Bray and servant Joseph
