Hop On Aboard the Air-Conditioned History Bus Tour June 20, 2015

The East Amwell Historical Society seems to know where all the bodies are buried, and the group is happy to clue you in. Join EAHS for its second cemetery tour, Grave Matters 2, on Saturday, June 20 featuring trips to five cemeteries.

The air-conditioned History Bus will head out to visit five cemeteries: four in East Amwell and one in neighboring Hopewell. The cemeteries are all different from the ones in last year's tour.

The historical society will offer morning and afternoon sessions of this tour with the bus leaving from the town hall parking lot. The morning session begins at 10:00 a.m. and the afternoon at 2:00 p.m. Tickets cost \$15 per person. The tour features stops at the Ringos' family burial ground, Union Cemetery, the Quick-Servis Cemetery and the Wertsville Baptist Church Cemetery. The trip will end at the First Baptist Church in Hopewell, which serves as the final resting place for Declaration of Independence signer John Hart.

Discover the fascinating stories of the men and women buried in these grounds ranging from American Revolutionary soldiers to someone who perished with the Titanic.
